



WATER STRIDER LOOP TRAILS -

Walking along waters

Circular walks that show all facets of Ötztal's varied waters.

Rushing mountain brooks, roaring waterfalls, quiet mountain lakes and the eternal ice. These trails are classified as easy to intermediate!



ÖTZTALER URWEG – Hiking from village to village

12 stages give a deep insight into the countless small and larger villages, leading past hidden places and exciting spots. These trails are classified as easy to intermediate. Important: walking times can be more than 5 hours!

ÖTZTAL TREK –

OTZTAL TREA Mountaineering, from hut to hut

The high alpine trail leads around Ötztal Valley. From lodge to lodge, across ridges and wind gaps. A mountain experience of the special kind. These trails are categorised from medium-difficult to difficult! High alpine tours, some of them across glacier areas!

Hiking tip for families

Piburger See



Follow Ötztaler Ache brook into the valley to the rafting access point and cross the bridge there. Continuing on the meadow trail, you will pass the small chapel. Above the chapel the trail leads into a broad forest trail up to lake Piburger See. The lake is idyllically embedded in the forest at the heart of the nature preserve. There is also a beautiful loop hiking trail around the lake. You can rent a rowing boat, take a wonderful swim or just relax. The way back travels along the wide forest trail to the "Wellerbrücke" (bridge) junction. Return to Oetz along Ötztaler Ache brook.

Sautner Forchet



More than 3000 years ago immense parts of the Tschirgant mountain massif crashed into the valley by blocking the entrance to Ötztal. Today this scenic area amidst the densely populated Tirolean Inntal has become a true nature treasure, almost untouched by men. The wood-covered oasis offers splendid spots, rich fauna and flora, and many myth-enshrouded stories. Two loop trails travel through this awesome landscape called "Sautner Forchet" known for its exciting cultural spots (Kalkofen area, cave house, ...). Information panels inform about fauna and geology. Please take enough to drink with you on hot summer days.

The route leads past Knappenhaus and picturebook Puchersee mountain lake, 2) Ascent via Bielefelder Hütte – this variant boasts fantastic views of the Oetz Region and towards Inntal valley. 3) From Acherberg Alm: first to old Bielefelder Hütte and then up to Wetterkreuz. 4) A rather sporty tour from Kühtai through Mittertal and across the ridge of Mittertaler Scharte.

Pirchkogel



The vantage mountain provides superb vistas. The variant starting in Kühtai promises a splendid hike via Pirchkogel. The climb across very steep Alpine meadows can be quite challenging, but as soon as you reach Gossenkölle mountain lakes the effort was worth it. At the top of the summit you can indulge in breathtaking views. The descent via Feldringer Böden pastures signs the end of a scenic hiking day. Don't miss a rest stop at Feldring Alm. Tip: car park at Ochsengartenbahn (base station) - for free - a public bus takes hikers up to Kühtai.

Once arrived at Nisslalm, the trail continues behind the hut to the wonderfully situated Alpine lake. The route travels westwards first, then it becomes steeper over grassy slopes up to Schönrinnenkar and via two further climbs to the lake. Return on the same route.

Gamskogel



Starting from the Spar supermarket in the center, follow the signs to Burgstein. On the high Alpine plateau walk into the village center and follow the Gamskogel marking on the left. Continue along the signposted, switch-backing forest trail until just before Wiesle (vantage point in the middle of the forest) and then follow the steep mountain trail until you reach the wide open Plattegg saddle. Always ascend on this broad, grassy saddleback which later becomes narrow and rocky. The summit can be reached via a short secured ridge. Return to Gries via Nisslalm. From there the hiking bus goes back to Längenfeld again.





This is a pristine high Alpine landscape that will enchant you for sure. You return across Alpine pastures to the small hamlet of Granstein and back to Sölden.

Söldenkogl




Söldenkogl is one of the local mountains of Sölden and can be climbed both in summer as in winter. Furthermore, Söldenkogl, even though it is not quite up there with the 3,000-metre peaks, is regarded as one of the most scenic mountains in Sölden.

The view of Sölden from Söldenkogl and the magnificent panorama of the Ötztal Alps' summits are a reward for the strenuous climb. The ascent can be shortened by taking a taxi to Kleble Alm or Fiegl's Gasthaus.

Hiking tip for families

Hohler Stein



"Hohler Stein" is a Stone Age hunting camp at an altitude of 2050 fm. Excavations prove the earliest use of the hunting base around 7600 BC. A lovely hiking tour that leads from Vent over the bridge of Niedertalbachbrook on the wide cart road towards Martin-Busch-Hütte. A narrow footpath travels through dense mountain pines to "Hohler Stein" hunting base.

Rofenhöfe



This easy trail follows the pastures to Rofenhöfe. Along the way you will come across several herds of Haflinger horses that spend the summer in the mountains. The old summit cross that used to be standing on Wildspitze, Tirol's highest peak, was put up on this trail and makes for a great photo.

The highlight and also end of this hike is the suspension bridge across Rofen Ache. The walk across the bridge is amazing and you get some great views! To return to the valley, follow the same way back.



Hiking tip for leisurely yet sporty hikers

Wilder Mann



From Vent take the twin-seat chair lift Wildspitze and the 6-seat chairlift Wildes Mannle to the upper terminus (2,646 m). Above the upper terminus take the turn-off to the right to Wilder Mann. The way up to the summit leads across steep and rocky terrain (secured by ropes). From there you have fabulous views of the Wildspitze Ortler-Group opposite. The descent first proceeds across the summit to the small wind gap and down along a secured path to the tongue of Rofenkar Glacier. From there you can walk down either to Breslauer Hütte or to Panoramarestaurant Stablein.



Hiking tip for mountaineers

Ötzi's Finding Place



This hike to the Iceman's discovery site is a must for all hikers interested in archeology. The ascent through Niedertal is long but easy. It's about 3 hours to Martin-Busch-Hütte and another 1.5 to 2 hours to Similaunhütte, which has been used as a mountain refuge for over 100 vears. From Similaunhütte it is a 1.5 hours hike to Ötzi's finding place. After a short excursion to the Stone Ages you descend either via Similaunhütte or past "Bild" area towards Martin-Busch-Hütte. Two days are required if you conquer also the higher regions, e.g. crossing Hochjochferner glacier towards Hochjoch Hospiz (Glaciertour).
