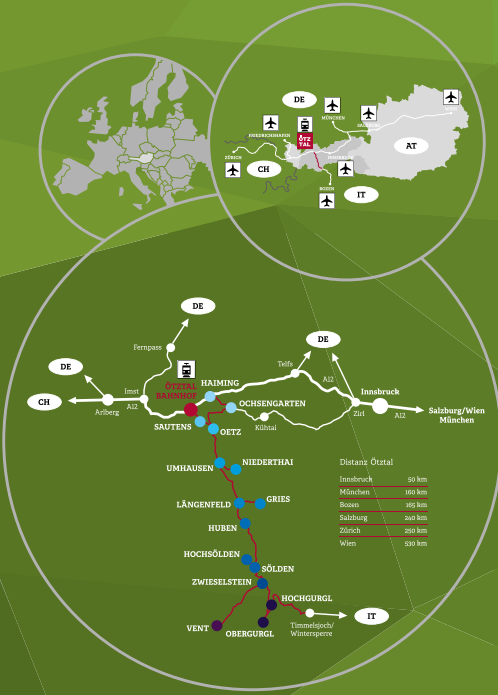

- Participants (single events): min. 2 / max. 15 persons – unless noted otherwise!
- For Nature Park partner business guests – book directly at the accommodation's reception
- Weekly hikes from 2 June – 16 October 2026
- Summer Card valid 4 June – 4 October 2026

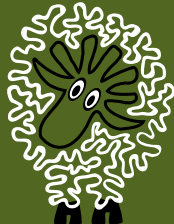

The NATURE PARK HOUSE in Längenfeld is the main hub for nature experiences and learning in the Ötztal valley. The bilingual, multimedia exhibition (German/English) covers 300 m² and showcases the fascinating flora and fauna using state-of-the-art technology - from VR and holograms to sensory stations, information boards and hand-carved exhibits.

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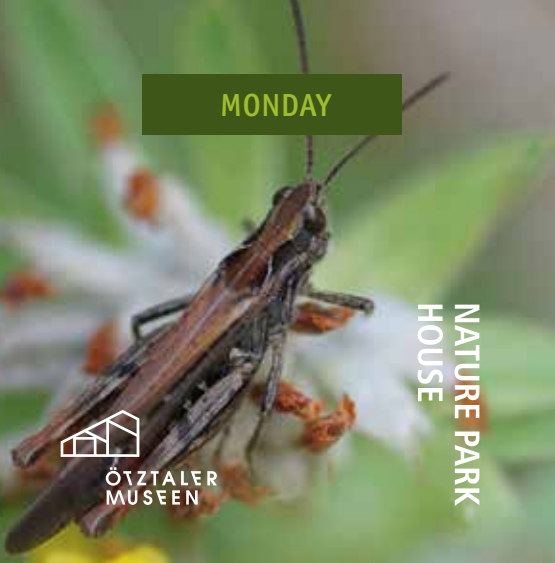
